Mr. Mitchell is retired from both military and civilian civil service. His military service included eight years of active duty aboard submarines and 22 years of reserve duty in a variety of staff and command positions in the Submarine Reserve. He played a principal role in establishing and maintaining the US Naval Submarine Reserve Program until his retirement as a Captain in 1994.

Mr. Mitchell served from 1971 to 2000 as a professional engineer, program manager, program management expert and Senior Executive at the Central Intelligence Agency. He held a wide range of staff and line management positions throughout the Intelligence Community. His 30-year career focused on planning and managing the development, test and field operation of large scale, state-of-the-art technical intelligence collection systems for space, terrestrial, and marine classified applications.

Mr. Mitchell is a graduate of the US Naval Academy, American University Business School, and Harvard University Kennedy School of Government.
